
## **ACCOMMODATION**

Characterful mid-terraced cottage sympathetically extended to the rear providing charming and contemporary accommodation throughout. The sitting room has been enhanced with wood flooring and bespoke oak cabinets fitted either side of the chimney breast with a feature woodburning stove creating a lovely focal point. A door from the sitting room leads to a delightful open-plan room which offers a modern and social feel, comprising a sitting area, a well-equipped galley style kitchen hosting an array of wall and base units, and a fantastic dining area with a lantern window and bi-folding doors leading to the garden. The family bathroom is also located on the ground floor and has recently been refurbished boasting new tiling and a traditional three-piece suite with a shower over the bath. Stairs from the sitting area offer access to the first floor where there are two well-proportioned bedrooms, with the principal bedroom benefitting from fitted storage. Externally, the property features a large rear garden which has been predominately laid with lawn with a multi-level decked terrace situated at the back of the garden providing access to the outbuilding.
